[Jeremiah 31:31-34](#)

During Lent this year, we'll be going through a sermon series called “The Heart of God.” In order for us to understand what it means to be a “Church After God’s Own Heart” we need to look at God’s heart. Join us each week as we dig into the character of God and get to know him better, so we can love others better.

PRAY & CONNECT

Open in prayer and invite the Holy Spirit into your conversation. Ask God for wisdom and discernment and trust him to guide you. Take time to recap the message or view it on [HopeOnline.tv](#). Did you have any “ah-ha” moments where you felt convicted, compelled, or inspired during the sermon? What’s been on your mind this week? Have you been able to apply the message to your everyday life?

GROW

Read [Jeremiah 31:31-34](#)

- Which way are you going? What are the things you need to turn away from? How can we know the way? What are idols? What are some idols in our world? What idols tempt you to worship them instead of God?

Read [Jeremiah 25:5, 11](#) - “*Seventy Years of Captivity*”

- How are we to read the prophets? How do we know if a prophet is true? When was the last time your faith was challenged? Are you too spiritually comfortable? Why is it good to be uncomfortable in our faith sometimes?

Read [Jeremiah 19:10-11](#)

- Does it ever feel like your world is falling apart? Does it ever feel like our world is falling apart? What does the Bible say about that? What is the purpose of the law? How is it like a mirror? How does it help us turn around and go God’s way?
- “Today is the day of our salvation.” What does that mean for us? Why is that significant? Where is the road to redemption?

APPLY

Spend time in prayer this week just listening to God. What is he revealing to you? Where in your life do you need to turn around? What is the life he is calling you to now? Think about the things you can do in your life to turn away from the things that are taking life from you. Go after the things that God is calling you to instead.
