



## Sermon Discussion Guide

"David"

[Acts 13:20-22](#)

In our first sermon series of the summer we'll be looking at a new hero in the Bible each week. What can we learn from these people and how can they help us live a more faithful and loving life? Join us each week to find out!

### PRAY & CONNECT

Open in prayer and invite the Holy Spirit into your conversation. Ask God for wisdom and discernment and trust him to guide you. Take time to recap the message or view it on [HopeOnline.tv](#). Did you have any "ah-ha" moments where you felt convicted, compelled, or inspired during the sermon? What's been on your mind this week? Have you been able to apply the message to your everyday life?

### GROW

Read [Acts 13:20-22](#) - "In Pisidian Antioch" & [1 Samuel 13:14](#) - "Samuel Rebukes Saul"

- What does it mean that David was a man after God's own heart? What does God want? In what areas of your life are you struggling with pride? How can we become more humble? What is humility? What is pride? How does pride turn us away from God? How does humility turn us toward God?

Read [Psalm 51](#) - "A Psalm of David"

- What is David going through in this Psalm? Where do you relate? Have you felt or experienced similar things?

Read [1 Samuel 16:7](#) - "David Anointed King"

- Why is this passage significant? In what ways do we look at people differently than God?
- What are some of the things David went through in his life? In what ways was he obedient to God? In what ways did he fail? Why is it significant that God still says that David is a man after his own heart?

### APPLY

Seek humility in your life this week. Spend time in prayer asking God to remove pride from your life and replace it with humility. Be open with your group about where you struggle with pride. Try being more curious about people rather than jumping to quick judgment.
