"Noah"

[Genesis 6:5-9](#)

In our first sermon series of the summer we'll be looking at a new hero in the Bible each week. What can we learn from these people and how can they help us live a more faithful and loving life? Join us each week to find out!

### PRAY & CONNECT

Open in prayer and invite the Holy Spirit into your conversation. Ask God for wisdom and discernment and trust him to guide you. Take time to recap the message or view it on [HopeOnline.tv](#). Did you have any "ah-ha" moments where you felt convicted, compelled, or inspired during the sermon? What's been on your mind this week? Have you been able to apply the message to your everyday life?

### GROW

#### Read [Genesis 6:1-9](#) - *"Wickedness in the World"*

- When was the last time you did something so outrageous that you were wondering why or if you could even do it? How do we know when God is calling us to step out in faith and trust him to do something? What was unique about Noah in his time? How was he able to hear what God was telling him?

#### Read [Genesis 1:31](#) - *"The Beginning"*

- What is this passage significant? What has gone wrong since this? What caused the flood in Chapter 6? What does God say about you in spite of your sin? What does the devil tell you about who you are because of your sin?

#### Read [1 John 1:8-10](#) - *"Light and Darkness, Sin and Forgiveness"*

- What does sin do to our relationship with God? Why should we confess our sins? What will God do for us when we do that? How can you practice confession in order to feel the freedom of forgiveness?

### APPLY

How can you open up about your struggles with sin with other believers? Find a relationship in your life that can speak God's forgiveness into your life, so you can be freed of the shame and guilt of sin. Allow that forgiveness to cleanse you and draw you closer to the Lord.
