[Genesis 22:15-18](#)

PRAY & CONNECT

Open in prayer and invite the Holy Spirit into your conversation. Ask God for wisdom and discernment and trust him to guide you. Take time to recap the message or view it on [HopeOnline.tv](#). Did you have any "ah-ha" moments where you felt convicted, compelled, or inspired during the sermon? What's been on your mind this week? Have you been able to apply the message to your everyday life?

GROW

Read [Deuteronomy 1:31](#) - "Rebellion Against the LORD"

- Who have been the people in your life who acted as a father figure to you? How did those people shape you and help you become the person you are today? What qualities did/do they exhibit? How are you doing those sort of things for others in your life? What opportunities do you have to care for others?

Read [Genesis 17:4-6](#) & [22:1-18](#) - "Abraham Tested"

- Has God ever asked you to step out in faith and do something that seemed strange or difficult? Have you ever been stretched by God? How did that go? Why do we need to be stretched sometimes? Have you ever left your home to go do something new in a new place? What is that experience like? How did God guide you and protect you through that?

Read [John 19:16-17](#) & [2 Corinthians 5:21](#)

- How does God provide for you today? What are the things that you need? Where do you need God to show up? Where is he already moving and where can you join him in that?

APPLY

Spend time in prayer this week thanking God for the people who have cared for, taken care of, and taught you throughout your life. Reach out to those people and thank them for being that person. Then, think about the relationships you have in your life and how you can pass those same things on to others in your life.
