PRAY & CONNECT

GROW

Read [Exodus 14:10-14](#); [3:5-6](#); [3:11, 13](#)

- What is surprising to you about Moses' life story? What does it teach about our following God? When was the last time God surprised you? Who is included in God's Kingdom?

Read [Exodus 4:10](#) & [John 6:9](#)

- What excuses do we sometimes make when it comes to the things God asks us to do? Do you ever feel like you're not _____ enough to be used by God? What does the story of Moses tell us?
- What is faith? Why is it important to following Jesus? What does faith allow us to do? Does faith come easy or difficult to you?

Read [Matthew 28:19](#) - "The Great Commission"

- How are you called to fulfill the Great Commission? What gifts have you been given to spread God's love to the world?

APPLY

Talk with your small group about the ways God has surprised you in the past. Share your stories of faith with each other; anywhere God has shown up. Allow those stories to build your faith and help you recognize where God has been at work in your life so that you can notice him working more and see how you can use those gifts.
