PRAY & CONNECT

Open in prayer and invite the Holy Spirit into your conversation. Ask God for wisdom and discernment and trust him to guide you. Take time to recap the message or view it on [HopeOnline.tv](#). Did you have any "ah-ha" moments where you felt convicted, compelled, or inspired during the sermon? What's been on your mind this week? Have you been able to apply the message to your everyday life?

GROW

Read [John 2:1-11](#) - "Jesus Changes Water Into Wine"

What was Jesus doing in this first miracle? How is it bringing the Kingdom of God to earth? What sort of time was he talking about in verse 4? Why does this matter? How does Jesus do similar things for us?

Read [Revelation 19:7-9](#) - "Threefold Hallelujah Over Babylon's Fall"

How is the Kingdom of God like a wedding? When have you experienced life to the fullest? When have you experienced heaven on earth? Where do we sometimes look for the good life other than Jesus? How can we experience the fullness of life that Jesus offers?

Read [John 10:10](#) - "The Good Shepherd and His Sheep"

What does it mean to have life to the full? When did you come to first experience this full life? What is the invitation Jesus offers? How can we extend that invitation to those who don't yet know Jesus? What makes this invitation appealing?

Read [Luke 5:27-32](#) - "Jesus Calls Levi and Eats with Sinners"

What did Matthew (Levi) do after meeting Jesus? How did he introduce more people to Jesus? How is this different than the ways we sometimes think about sharing our faith with others?

APPLY

What has Jesus done for your life? Talk about that with your group. How has he changed your life for the better. Then, write down the things he's done for you. Think about the people in your life who don't know Jesus. How can you introduce them to Jesus like Matthew (Levi) did in Luke 5?
