**SERIES:** 10 Commandments

**TOPIC:** You + Others (Honor/Honesty)



**Big Questions:** How WELL do <u>YOU</u> treat others? How WELL do <u>OTHERS</u> treat you? Does it even matter how people treat each other? Does it matter if we are kind/loving? WHY? How well are you HONORING your parents? (What does that even mean?) Are you being HONEST when you speak with others? Does the TRUTH actually matter? WHY or WHY NOT?

**Main Takeaway:** Did you know you can learn how to avoid hurting others (AND YOURSELF) by simply following God's Commands!? Honor your parents. (Be kind, respectful, truthful!) Don't murder, cheat, steal or lie! Don't waste time wishing you had someone else's life!

- POP QUIZ: Who did God give the 10 commandments to? (Moses!)
  - The first THREE Commandments are all about YOU and WHO? (YOU + GOD!)
- #1 (no other gods) // #2 (Don't misuse God's name) // #3 (Keep the Sabbath day Holy!)
- The rest of the Commandments are all about YOU and WHO? (YOU + OTHERS!)
  - #4 Re-Read Deuteronomy 5:16 (Honor your father and mother)
    - What does it mean to Honor your parents?
       (Obey. Listen to. Respect. Speak kindly of, even when they're not around.)
  - #5 Re-Read Deuteronomy 5:17 (Don't MURDER)
    - Why do you suppose God even made this a commandment?
  - #6 Re-Read Deuteronomy 5:18 (Don't CHEAT)
    - How does it feel when someone cheats?
  - o #7 Re-Read Deuteronomy 5:19 (Don't STEAL)
    - Have you ever had something stolen from you? What? How did you feel?
  - #8 Re-Read Deuteronomy 5:20 (Don't LIE)
    - Why do you think people avoid the truth (or lie) about things?
  - o #9 & 10 Re-Read Deuteronomy 5:21 (Don't wish for someone else's life!)
    - Why do think God doesn't want us to wish for someone else's stuff?
