SERIES: 10 Commandments

TOPIC: You + God (Holy/Humble)



Big Questions: What is the MOST IMPORTANT thing in your life? There are lots of good answers to that question. (My Family, Friends, Getting Good Grades, Being Health, Winning a Big Game, etc.) But did you know the Bible is VERY clear on what our answer should be? The MOST IMPORTANT part of your life is your relationship with God! Does that mean those other things are not important? Not at all! But if you put GOD FIRST, everything else will fall into place. If you have a GREAT family, nice friends, good grades, and win big games, but DON'T have God... you're going to miss out on the MOST IMPORTANT part of life! Why should people put God first? How do actually put God first? What's that look like?

Takeaway: It's one thing to KNOW that God should be most important in your life, but it's another thing altogether to actually MAKE GOD the MOST IMPORTANT part of your life! Your ACTIONS will reveal how important God is to you! Is God waiting for us to love him before he will love us? No! He ALREADY sent his son Jesus to die for your sins! He already created you in his image, and he already loves you THE MOST he could ever love you! Now, it's up to you to realize this truth, and live it out each and every day!

- Who did God give the 10 commandments to? (Moses)
- What are the first three commandments?
 - #1 Re-Read Exodus 20:3 (No other gods)
 - What are some other "gods" that people put before God?
 - #2 Re-Read Exodus 20:7 (Don't misuse God's name)
 - What are some examples of people misusing God's name?
 - OMG // I swear to... // saying the name Jesus Christ inappropriately
 - o #3 Re-Read **Exodus 20:8** (Observe the Sabbath day, keep it Holy!)
 - What is the Sabbath? (day of rest) Why is it important to God?
- Why do you suppose God wants to make sure you know these rules?
- How is a life with GOD FIRST a better way to live?
- What is ONE THING you could change this week to help put your relationship w/ God first?

Romans 6:23 (page 1366)

+ <u>HIGHLIGHT</u> this verse! Take time to memorize it! Repeat it over and over SEVEN times in your own mind to practice knowing it by heart!

PRACTICE "SEARCHING" THE BIBLE!
