CHECK-IN

BIBLE STORY REVIEW

GET THIS:

Bible Reading Handout

DO THIS:

Read the scripture below:

Always be full of joy in the Lord. I say it again—rejoice! Let everyone see that you are considerate in all you do. Remember, the Lord is coming soon.[a]

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

REVIEW QUESTIONS:

1. What is a thanksgiving tradition that your family has?
2. Who are you grateful for this year?
3. How can you share God's love with the people who mean the most to you?
4. What is the memory verse today? (See section above)

CRAFT

GET THIS:

Gratitude tree, leaves, glue, scissors, markers

DO THIS:

1. Give each student a gratitude tree paper and a paper with leaves. Have them decorate the leaves and write down someone or something they are grateful for on each one. (They do not have to use every leaf.)
2. When they have written on the leaves that they want to, then they can cut them out.
3. Finish the craft by gluing the leaves on to the tree to make it colorful and full of everything they are thankful for this season.

CONNECTION POINT:

This is the perfect time of year to reflect on the people and things in our lives that make us who we are today. If you are ever having a bad day use this craft as a reminder of all who have your back, love and support you!

ACTIVITY

GET THIS:

Feathers

DO THIS:

1. Explain that they will be playing a game called turkey feather float.
2. Give each person a feather, everyone gets their own feather. You can either have everyone go at once or in smaller groups depending on space
3. Tell the players they have 60 seconds to see who can keep their feather floating in the air the longest just by blowing on it.
4. They can only use air to keep the feather up, once it touches the ground or another object that player is out for the round.
