Registration: Opens Wednesday, Jan. 28, at 9:00 am. Space is limited to the **first 48 travelers** who register, so we encourage you to complete your registration ASAP! Once the trip is full, there will be an opportunity to be placed on a waitlist. Based on the number of people on the waitlist, we may consider duplicating this trip in the future.

Cost: \$500 per person deposit required at registration. Remaining balance due 60 days prior to the departure date (you will receive an email at that time with instructions). No refunds will be issued by Fellowship Travelers 60 days before departure.

Included: Transportation (top-rated motor coach), overnight accommodations (four hotels), meals (four breakfasts, four lunches, two dinners), and all listed events.

Trip insurance: Strongly encouraged. During registration, you will have the opportunity to add trip insurance. The new company offers three levels of coverage. You can [purchase trip insurance](#) up to 24 hours before the departure date.

Itinerary:



Sunday, June 21: Arrive at the Valley Community Center for your Wisconsin Water Cruise Adventure! Travel on a spacious motor coach to Dubuque, IA, where we'll enjoy a catered dinner, followed by a relaxing evening at the famous Hotel Julien.



Monday, June 22: Travel along the Great River Road following the mighty Mississippi to La Crosse, WI. Keep your eyes peeled for the many eagles feeding their young along this scenic byway. Then board the La Crosse Queen for a three-hour lunch cruise on the Mississippi. Once we regain our land legs, we will motor east to the ever-popular tourist town of Wisconsin Dells, where we'll enjoy dinner and retire for the day.



Tuesday, June 23: After breakfast, we board the Wisconsin Dells cruise boat for a two-hour tour on the Wisconsin River. Photo opportunities are plentiful as we exit the boat several times to explore crevices and unique rock formations. Marvel at the beautiful views at Witches Gulch and Stand Rock. Lunch options are available on Wisconsin Dells Broadway Street. Later, we check into The Inn on Maritime Bay at Manitowoc, WI, with a surprise presentation on the lakefront.



Wednesday, June 24: Awake with a view of Lake Michigan, and then enjoy a catered breakfast before touring the Wisconsin Maritime Museum, where 28 WWII submarines were built and launched (the Cobia is retired here). Board the coach for the Edelweiss Harbor in

Milwaukee for a private two-hour luncheon cruise. Stunning views will provide plenty of photo opportunities as we cruise through the heart of Milwaukee and into Lake Michigan. After returning to the harbor, enjoy a scenic one-hour drive to Lake Geneva, stopping at Lake Geneva Country Meats. Next, arrive at the pristine lakeside Harbor Shore Resort for two nights. Enjoy the ambiance and relaxing lifestyle of the rich and famous.

Thursday, June 25: Enjoy breakfast in your suite or on Main Street, then leave for lunch on Lake Geneva for a two-and-a-half-hour narrated cruise, highlighting famous homeowners, including the Wrigleys, Schwinn, and Drakes, as well as movie stars and financial notables. Following the luncheon, tour the many shops just blocks away.

Friday, June 26: This is the Frank Lloyd Wright day, where we will travel to Spring Green, WI. The day begins with a tour of the grand Taliesin Preservation, a beautiful 800-acre estate, the personal residence of Wright, his four sons, and three daughters. We will also see Wright's private study and iconic living room. After lunch, we will visit House on the Rock, where you can meander through various sections at your own pace. Later, we will drive to Dubuque and check into the Julien Hotel for the evening.

Saturday, June 27: After a hot catered breakfast, we will travel to Dyersville, IA, for a stop at the beautiful Basilica of Saint Frances Xavier. Finally, we will go to the captivating Field of Dreams, where we will have a guided tour, and then head back to West Des Moines.

All activities, venues, and destinations are subject to change.

Activity level: Must be able to board and depart motor coaches and boats on your own, feel comfortable on your feet on tours, walk inside and outdoor distances on uneven terrain in all weather conditions, and manage luggage. Mobility devices are allowed (canes, walking sticks, walkers, rollators, etc.). Walkers and rollators must be stored under the motor coach with luggage.

Dietary restrictions: We do our best to try to accommodate dietary restrictions, but you are encouraged to bring snacks and food in compliance with your dietary restrictions.

Comfort stops: Comfort stops are made every two to two-and-a-half hours. However, the motor coach is equipped with an onboard toilet to be used only as necessary.

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
