"But I tell you, love your enemies.
Pray for those who hurt you."

Matthew 5:44 (ICB)

BIBLE STORY

The Perfect Message for Imperfect People
Love Your Enemy | Jacob & Esau

Matthew 5:43-48

CHECK-IN

4:45 PM // 9:00 AM // 10:45 AM [WELL]

- Give each child a wristband & give the pull off tab to the parent.
- Use extra name tag to build your roster for the day.
- While waiting for programming to start students can color or play games.

OPENING

- Bring your group to sit together for announcements.
- Help facilitate behaviors, encourage participation & quiet your group when the speaker is talking.

BIBLE STORY REVIEW

GET THIS:

Bible Reading Handout

DO THIS:

Read the Bible story and answer the discussion questions below.

REVIEW QUESTIONS:

1. What were the two brothers fighting over?
2. What is a lesson that you are taking away from class today?
3. What is the golden rule and how does it apply to our lesson today? (Treat others as you would like to be treated)
4. What is the memory verse today? (See section above)

CRAFT

GET THIS:

Clothes pins, markers

DO THIS:

1. Give each student 2 clothes pins and have them start by writing something nice/positive on one side.
2. They can decorate the other side as they would like.
3. Now its time to love the people around you, either here at church or out in the community try to pin someone. By doing this you are to sneakily get your clothes pin attached to something they are wearing (back of their shirt, on their hat, etc.)

CONNECTION POINT:

Pinning it forward and sharing your kindness with others can bring those around you great joy! This is a fun trend that is typically seen at sporting events between teams as a way of loving one another. Now its your turn to share the love and kindness just like Jesus would!

ACTIVITY

GET THIS:

Kindness Calendar, Markers, pencils

DO THIS:

1. Give each student a kindness calendar, read through what each of the days says and encourage the students to complete their act of kindness each day.
2. Some of the days are blank, have kids come up with their own acts of kindness on those days and write it in.
3. When finished filling in the calendar, give them time to decorate and add colors as they would like.

CONNECTION POINT:

God encourages us to treat everyone with love and kindness even your enemies. Use this calendar to help you share love and kindness each day.

CHECKOUT

- As parents come they will enter through the middle door, and show the tab that needs to be matched with that child's wristband. After they have been checked out send them out one of the two side doors.
