### MEMORY VERSE

"People judge by outward appearance,  
but the Lord looks at the heart."

1 Samuel 16:7b

### BIBLE STORY

The Biggest & Boldest Opening Line Ever!  
David

1 Samuel 16

### CHECK-IN

## BIBLE STORY REVIEW

GET THIS:

Bible Reading Handout

DO THIS:

Read the Bible story and answer the discussion questions below.

REVIEW QUESTIONS:

1. What town was David from? (Bethlehem)
2. What was Samuel sent to do? (Find the next King of Israel)
3. What were some words that were used to describe David? (young, small, etc.)
4. What is the memory verse today? (See section above)

## CRAFT

### GET THIS:

Heart cut out, scissors, markers

### DO THIS:

1. Give each student a heart paper.
2. Have them fold the paper in half, hamburger style and have the heart facing them.
3. Cut out around the heart from the bottom & sides. **DO NOT FULLY CUT OUT THE HEART.** Leave the tops of the hearts connected so that you can open it up like a card.
4. On the inside of the heart have them write down things that are considered "outside appearances" or things that people see about them. EX: clothes, hobbies, activities
5. On the outside of the heart have them write down things that are considered "inside qualities" about themselves. EX: kind, brave, loving, honest

### CONNECTION POINT:

God looks at what is on the inside, David was young but on the inside he was so much more.

## ACTIVITY

### GET THIS:

Hearts

### DO THIS:

1. Scatter the hearts around the room
2. Have the kids find a heart and based on the word they see on it they need to decide if its an "inside" word or "outside" word.
3. Designate which side of the room is "inside" and which side is "outside" and the kids can split up based on the word they have.
4. Go down each line and have the kid read out the word they have and why they picked the side that they did.

### CONNECTION POINT:

Jesus has a big heart for each of us and all the different qualities that we have. Think about the words you heard today, what are qualities that you have?

## CHECKOUT
