MEMORY VERSE

"Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, 'My child, your sins are forgiven.'"

Mark 2:5

BIBLE STORY

Faith that Tears off the Roof!
The Paralyzed Man

Mark 2:1-12

CHECK-IN

4:45 PM // 9:00 AM // 10:45 AM [WELL]

- Give each child a wristband & give the pull off tab to the parent.
- Use extra name tag to build your roster for the day.
- While waiting for programming to start students can color or play games.

OPENING

BIBLE STORY REVIEW

GET THIS:

Bible Reading Handout

DO THIS:

Read the Bible story and answer the discussion questions below.

REVIEW QUESTIONS:

1. What injury did the man have who was brought to Jesus? (He was paralyzed so couldn't walk)
2. Why did the friends send their friend through a hole in the roof? (They couldn't get to Jesus due to the crowds)
3. Jesus did two things for the man, what were they? (Healed the man & forgave him of his sins)
4. What is the memory verse today? (See section above)

CRAFT

GET THIS:

Coloring page, scissors, markers

DO THIS:

1. Pass out materials to each student.
2. Have them cut out the pieces of the craft and color them as they would like.
3. The building part of the craft is pre-cut with a slit to slip the strip of paper through to raise and lower the paralyzed man.
4. Finish assembling the pieces together.

CONNECTION POINT:

Jesus performed many miracles, when we have faith we are likely to see him show up in one way or another.

ACTIVITY

GET THIS:

Bean bag, cart drawer

DO THIS:

1. Take your services drawer out of the cart and place on the ground.
2. Have the group line up at a specified distance away from the drawer.
3. Hand the first person in line a bean bag and have them try to toss the bean bag into the drawer.
4. Allow everyone a turn, if you want to do multiple rounds move the drawer further and further away from the line to make it harder for them to make it in.

CONNECTION POINT:

The paralyzed man had friends help to get him to Jesus to be healed. With this activity you are the friends helping get the bean bag to the drawer.

CHECKOUT
