TOPIC: “7” (Divine Completion & Perfection!)

OVERVIEW for TONIGHT!

- We can learn so much about God, simply by looking at NUMBERS in the Bible!
 - Last week, we discussed the number “12”, what do you remember about it?
 - **Our focus during this series is about numerical values and what they represent, and how we can learn about God, simply by doing the MATH!**
- Tonight, we are going to focus on the number... SEVEN! Pop Quiz Time!
 - God created everything in 6 days, and then **RESTED** on day...? **(7!)**
 - **Joseph interprets Pharaoh’s dream**, how many fat cows? **(7!)** thin cows? **(7!)**
 - This meant how many years of abundance? **(7!)** years of famine? **(7!)**
 - How many **DAYS** did God’s people walk around the walls of **JERICHO**? **(7!)**
 - How many times did they march around the walls on the 7th Day? **(7!)**
 - How many priests? **(7!)** were blowing how many horns? **(7!)**
 - How many **baskets of LEFTOVERS** were collected after feeding the 4,000? **(7!)**
 - While on the cross, **JESUS** spoke how many times? **(7!)**
 - In **REVELATION**, how many churches? **(7!)** Lampstands? **(7!)** Seals? **(7!)**
 - Trumpets? **(7!)** Bowls? **(7!)** Thunders? **(7!)** Crowns? **(7!)**

Takeaway: Each of these stories demonstrates God’s **DIVINE COMPLETION** & **PERFECTION!**

OPEN YOUR BIBLES!

- **Remind students to bring their Bibles EVERY Week!**
- **NOTE:** encourage students to work together & find the pages. **HIGHLIGHT** each verse!
 - **(OLD TESTAMENT) Genesis 2:1-3 (page 6)**
 - In verse 3 what did God do with the 7th Day? (He **BLESSED** it! Declared it **HOLY!**)
 - He **RESTED!** Why do you suppose God decided REST is so important?
 - **Have you been getting REST that is HOLY & BLESSED?**
 - Share with the group how you REST? Is it hard to do? Why?
 - The number SEVEN represented God's COMPLETION of CREATION.
 - Think of a time when you COMPLETED something hard? What was it?
 - (Maybe a season? An activity? A task? A project? A test? Etc.)
 - How did it feel to be done? (did you REST afterward?)
 - How will you find time to REST during SPRING BREAK?
 - **READ & REVIEW A "SEVEN" STORY!**
 - Pick one of these stories which all feature the number "7" and read it!
 - Joseph interprets Pharaoh's Dreams (Genesis 41:1-36 // page 52)
 - **BONUS:** Snapshot of Joseph (page 49)
 - The Fall of Jericho (Joshua 6:1-16 // page 242)
 - **BONUS:** Snapshot of Joshua (page 245)
 - Elisha tells Naaman to wash in Jordan River (2 Kings 5:1-19 // pg. 424)
 - **BONUS:** Snapshot of Naaman! (page 425)
 - Jesus tells Peter to forgive (70 X 7) (Matthew 18:21-22 // page 1148)
 - **BONUS:** Why does forgiveness matter? (page 1461)
 - **How did "7" represent DIVINE COMPLETION & PERFECTION in this story?**
